## Traffic Notice: Large Turbine deliveries on Killybegs/Letterkenny/Derry Road

## 10th October 2016

ESB's Eglish Wind Farm is currently under construction in Co Tyrone. Comprising six turbines, the wind farm will produce enough clean electricity to power 7,000 homes. Now at the advanced construction stage, turbines for the project will be transported from Killybegs to Derry (route map below) commencing in the early morning of Wednesday 12th October.

All abnormal loads will be made via the project's turbine delivery route, which is mapped below. Deliveries will take place between 3 am and 7.30 am minimising disruption to road users in Co. Donegal.

While no road closures are necessary, a Garda escort will accompany all abnormal loads assisting with traffic management.

The turbines components will enter Killybegs, having been shipped from various locations around Europe. From Killybegs, they will then travel by road along the N56, bypassing Donegal Town, before continuing on the N15/N13 to Letterkenny and on to Derry. Deliveries will run intermittently over a period of approximately 5 weeks during these early morning hours.
