Dear EV Driver,

As an EV driver, you are part of an exciting transition to a low carbon, net zero future for all. Our team has been working continuously to improve the ESB EV public charging network and the service we provide.

Survey Updates:

Firstly, we would like to thank all customers who participated in our customer survey before Christmas. Your feedback is much appreciated and will help us to improve our network in 2023 and beyond.

While we are still working through the data, there are some clear themes. We identified that 55% of our users use a CCS connector, compared to 29% using CHAdeMO. 62% of people live within 5km of their closest ESB charger, meaning you'll never be far from your next charge! 77% of people in ROI use the ESB charging network as either their main charge point or to supplement their charging needs, which shows how important our public charging is for our customers.

Awareness of the ecar connect app remained high at 95%, with 72% finding it useful. 67% of people are satisfied with our customer care and those who made contact, did so via phoning our call centre.

New additions to our EV charging network:

There have been new additions to our charging network in recent months. These chargers can be found in the following locations:

- SuperValu Knocklyon, Knocklyon Road, Templeogue Village, Dublin 16, D16 W2V0. There is one high power charger (150kW) and one fast (50kW) charger available at this site.
- Supervalu Kimmage, Sundrive Shopping Centre, Sundrive Road, Kimmage, Dublin 12. There is one high power (150kW) charger and one fast (50 kW) charger available at this site.
- Park Pointe Shopping Centre, Glenageary Road Upper, Dun Laoghaire, Dublin. There is one 100 kW dual CCS charger available

• Loughrea Service Station (TOP), Athenry Road, Loughrea Co. Galway. There are now two 100kW dual CCS chargers available at this location.
