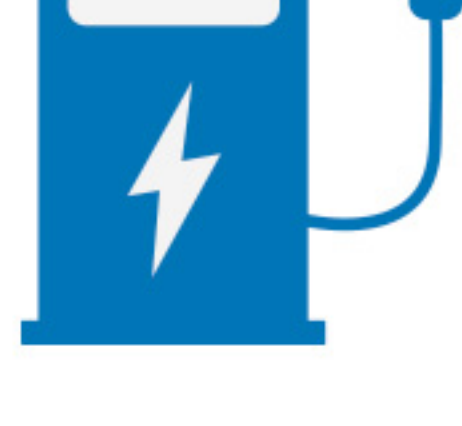
Government incentive of up to €5,000 grant per vehicle and up to €5,000 vehicle registration tax relief.

Government grant of up to €600 towards a home charger.

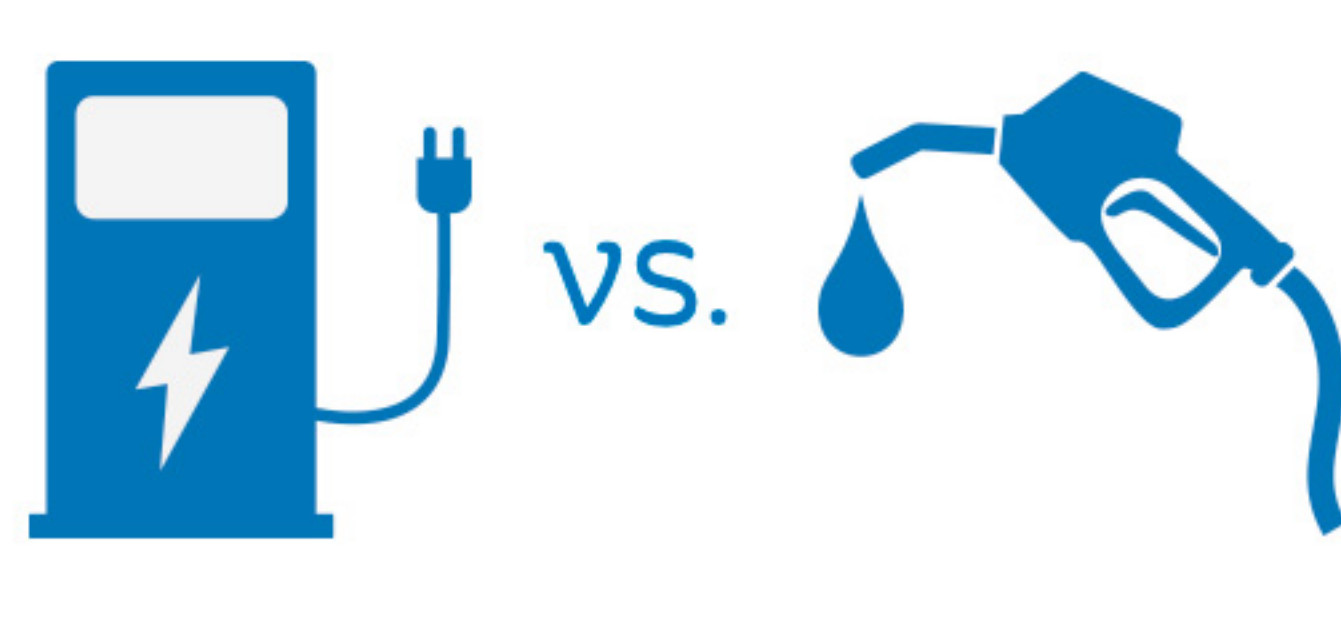


ESB public charging network with 1100 charge points on the island of Ireland.

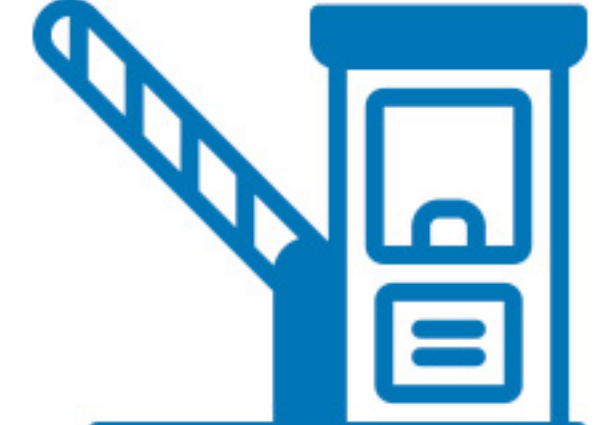
## Reduced running costs

Electric vehicle drivers with a home charger can save 66% versus a diesel equivalent.

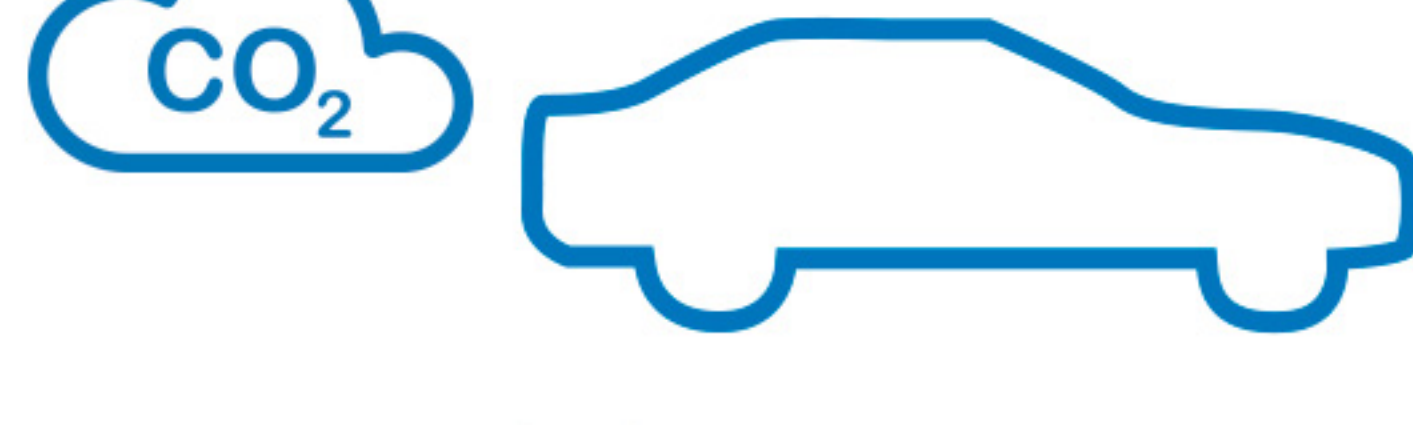

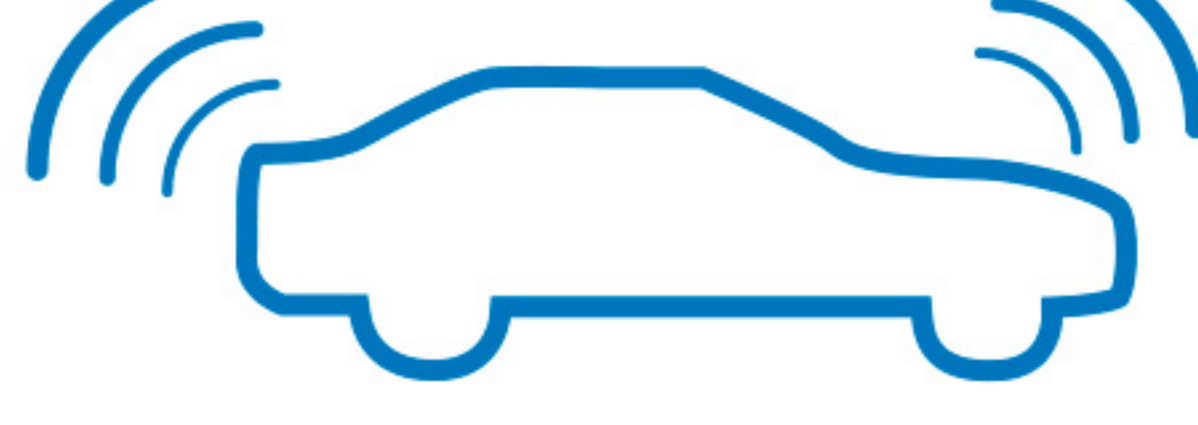
